## Bachelor

## Master

The Master of Laws (LL.M) started successfully in Summer Term 2008. It aims on Bachelor of Laws owners or comparable degrees with good grades.

It is possible to start the Master Program in the Winter and Summer term. It leads to the international recognized degree Master of Laws (LL.M.) in a total of 3 terms, giving the graduates a qualification for higher services.

The Study is accredited by the FIBAA and includes 90 ECTS. It is designed as a full time study with

having the third term reserved for the Master Thesis.
